Opportunities for Public Parks or Pocket Parks - “Pearls”



As stated in the Town of Mount Pleasant’s *Coleman Boulevard – Ben Sawyer Boulevard Revitalization Plan 2005*, and as further recommended by Seamon, Whiteside and Associates, Inc., the Town should pursue the development of pocket parks within the plan area or within close proximity. The parks should be easily accessible to the public and should include amenities such as benches and picnic areas.

The Town should consider adding interactive features to each park that either reflects on a historical moment or unique feature of Mount Pleasant. The creation of these pocket parks may require acquisition of property by the Town or partnerships with property owners. For example, partnership opportunities may exist where pieces of property are unusable for development but are suitable for a pocket park.
